Eligibility:

- Must be a **graduate student** in Computer Science in good standing. For new master students, must be admitted without conditions; or current master students already completed all admission conditions.
- Students must have a **GPA of 3.3 or higher** in all the computer science graduate course work attempted at UTSA and demonstrate satisfactory progress toward the study of the degree.
- Preference will be given to students who are also graders in the Department.
- A student may not receive this scholarship more than two times.

This is a competitive scholarship. Recipients will receive \$1,000 and qualify for an in-state tuition waiver.
